This programme demonstrates their dedication to the on-going preservation and improvement of the many buildings on the Estate and the surrounding landscape, which is of international importance.

The work undertaken by HOW Planning and The Paul Drury Partnership will result in proposals to assess the feasibility of future developments at Castle Howard and its long term sustainability.
